Grade Marks Calculation - (In order to convert the marks to points, percentage of marks obtained in any examination is to be multiplied by the marks allotted e.g. an applicant obtaining 60% marks in Madhyamik or its equivalent is to be multiplied by 0.10 to get point (6) Aggregate percentage is calculated on the basis of marks obtained in all subjects and not best of four /five.

Selection of School Subject

The candidate must select any one School Subject that was studied as an Honours subject at UG Level or Masters Level. If the subjects are different, a letter of permission from C.U. will be required at the time of admission.

Procedure of uploading documents:

- b) Original documents have to be scanned (150 DPI resolution). Mobile pictures are strictly prohibited
- c) While scanning the Original Marksheet and Admit Card students are required to sign on plain white paper and place it below the documents. The Final scanned document should include the Marksheet/Admit card and the signature below.

Reservation of Seats

There will be limited seats reserved for students from Universities other than Calcutta as per University rules. Students from other Universities are to produce a letter of permission from Calcutta University if necessary. Seats will be reserved for SC/ST students and persons with disabilities as per University rules.

- ✓ Reservations of seats will be admitted only after production and verification of original certificates issued by authorized persons / competent authority.

Other Rules

 All candidates, deputed and freshers will have to sit for Test and Tutorials that are held from time to time. Deputed teachers will not be exempted. Any student, whether deputed or fresher, absenting herself on any ground in Tests and Tutorials throughout the session will not be sent up for Final Examination.
