




## B.A.(H) / B.Sc.(H):

- \* Check your Name, Course & Semester
- \* Choose your (Generic Elective) GE1& AECC1 for Semester-I from drop down. GE1 will be taught in Semester-I & Semester-III. AECC1 applicable only for Semester-I.




❖ After choosing subject click **Save**. Semester-I subjects will be saved.


Then move to Semester-II. \




\* Choose (Generic Elective) GE2 for Semester-II from drop down. GE2 will be taught in Semester-II & Semester-IV. Click Save.




❖ Click Save for Semester-III CBCS.




❖ Click Save for Semester-IV CBCS.
