

Online Education in India during the Pandemic Covid-19: Opportunities and Challenges

Abstract

The outbreak of global pandemic novel corona virus (covid-19) has lead to closures of various schools, colleges and universities around the world. India is no exception according to recent report by UNESCO, over one and a half billion school & college students were stuck at home in the midst of the ongoing pandemic, representing close to 90% of the global student population (c. 1.38 bn students) at a point in March 2020. In this scenario, advancement in technology, both computational as well as telecommunication, are enabling schools worldwide to bring remote learning opportunities to students.

In this paper, an attempt is made to understand the opportunities and challenges faced by students while getting education online during this pandemic. Around 200 students, of different age groups and different institutions from Kolkata were surveyed in this regard to understand the outcome.
