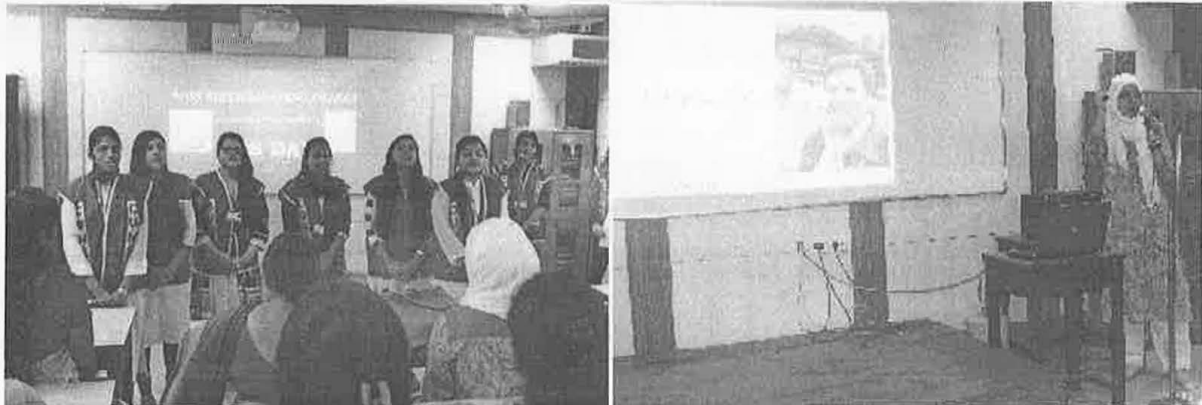

A session on Research Orientation was organised by faculty members by the PG section of the Department of English along with the Central Research Committee on 23 March 2018. The resource person was Dr Krishna Sen, former Professor and Head of the Department of English, Calcutta University. The lecture was attended by 55 teachers from various departments of all three streams of Arts, Commerce and Science. Dr Sen spoke about the importance of research activities for faculty members at all stages of their career. Acknowledging the many differences in research in the different streams, she endeavoured to outline a few general principles that could be followed by all. She focussed on the many reputed agencies - both national and international - that could serve as crucial initiators, sponsors and target institutions for faculty research. Dr Sen emphasised the importance of following up on the different grants available to early and mid-career research scholars as well as the attendant challenges in securing them. She invited questions from the audience and helped to clarify the many doubts that the faculty members had about the tenets, tenure and topicality of their proposed areas of study, their planned projects and their research roadmaps. The outcomes of this unique and extremely relevant session was highly enhanced motivation for the faculty members to pursue research in their chosen fields, broadening of their knowledge base about possibilities and potentials of research topics and also an informed judgement about the way forward.
