Brief description:

The NSS Unit of the College organized a hydration initiative titled “NSS Water Mates.” 120 litres of water was distributed around 150 (approx) commuters. The project was undertaken with the objective of ensuring access to clean and safe drinking water for the public and promoting social responsibility among student volunteers.

NSS volunteers actively participated in establishing and managing drinking water distribution points at the designated location. As part of the initiative, 120 litres of clean and purified drinking water was provided free of cost to approximately 150 beneficiaries. The initiative catered to a diverse group of individuals, including pedestrians, daily wage workers, commuters, and local residents.

The volunteers ensured proper maintenance of hygiene standards throughout the programme. Drinking water was served in an organized manner and regular replenishment was arranged to maintain uninterrupted availability.
