- **BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE EVENT-**

Like every year, in 2026 too, the B.Ed. department of Shri Shikshayatan college arranged an institutional visit as a part of "**Creating an Inclusive School**" and the **Community Outreach Service Unit** activity.

On 14.03.2026, ten students of the B.Ed. department visited **Calcutta Blind School** to observe and understand the teaching - learning methods of visually impaired children. The B.Ed. trainees got to know about the teaching learning process and materials of the visually impaired students like the Braille paper, Braille Books, Braille Maps, and other multi-sensory aids, the history of the school, the co-curricular activities, the achievements of the students etc. From the B.Ed. department materials like Blind Stick, Clay modelling set, yoga mat, first aid box with elements, sanitary napkins, food items etc. were donated to support the students of the school.

- **OUTCOME-**

It was a fulfilling and enriching experience for the B.Ed. trainees. Learning about the Braille system and other multi-sensory teaching aids, how the visually impaired students are taught and also different problems of the students helped the trainees to build empathy, understand inclusive education better through first-hand experience and prepare themselves to handle diverse learners in their future teaching career as a part of inclusive classroom.
