Brief description of the event: The Special Lecture on the thought-provoking topic “Femininity as a Loss That Cannot Be Mourned” was organised for both the undergraduate and postgraduate students as well as Faculty members to provide an engaging platform for exploring contemporary debates in feminist theory, psychoanalysis and gender studies. The session encouraged critical reflection on the social and cultural construction of femininity.

Outcome: The references to literature, philosophy and popular culture reflected the importance of questioning inherited gender norms and recognising the emotional and cultural dimensions of loss experienced by women. The session proved to be intellectually stimulating and highly enriching, broadening the participants’ understanding of feminist discourse while strengthening their analytical engagement with literature and culture.
