DESCRIPTION: An educational field visit to Ramakrishna Mission Blind Boys Academy, Narendrapur was organised by the Education Department in collaboration with the Department of Education, Sivanath Sastri College. The objective of the visit was to provide Semester 5 students of Education Honours experiential learning on education of the visually challenged – a chapter included in the paper ‘Inclusion in Education’.

During the guided visit, students were taken to the Room of Concept Formation, where tactile teaching aids were used for learning; the Braille Library and Press, which prepares and publishes Braille materials; the ITI Section for vocational training; the Agriculture Section for practical skill development; and the IT Lab equipped with assistive technologies for visually impaired learners.

OUTCOME: The collaborative programme gave students of the two colleges an opportunity to learn together and share their experiences. The institutional visit helped students develop a clear understanding of education practices for learners with visual impairment. It sensitized them to the use of assistive devices, tactile learning materials, and vocational training in inclusive education settings. The visit also enhanced students’ awareness of the role of institutions in promoting independence, dignity, and holistic development among children with special needs.
