Description of the Event: On 27th July 2026, 2 students of Semester VII Botany Major attended a Seminar titled International Mangrove Day, 2026 organised by WWF India, West Bengal State Office and Sea Explorer Institute.

The programme comprised of a mangrove sensitization session, a mangrove trail visit and hands on learning with an interactive classroom session.

The seminar focused on the importance of the Sundarbans mangrove ecosystem and the need for its conservation. Students were introduced to different mangrove species, their habitats, adaptations and unique ecosystem. During field visit they were exposed to mangrove-associated fauna.

Outcome: The seminar and field visit offered an enriching learning experience to the students as they gained practical knowledge in identifying mangrove species and understanding their ecological significance. The programme inspired them to contribute towards conservation and sustainable management of mangrove biodiversity leading to the protection of valuable coastal ecosystems.
