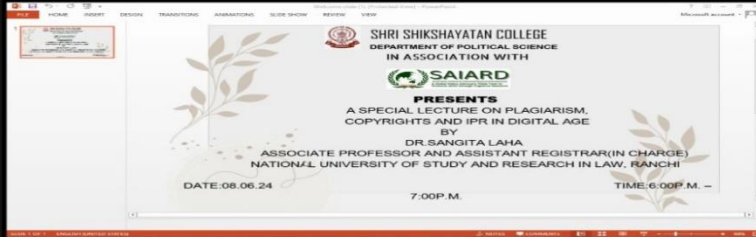
TOPIC: Plagiarism, Copyrights and IPR in Digital Age
