MEDICAL COMMITTEE REPORT

- As in every year the Medical Committe of the college began the session with an inspection of the First Aid Kit and equipments for checking vital statistics that are available in the college office for the benefit of the students and members of the teaching staff. The committee also updated the staff and students with notices on the available medical facilities in the college.
- The committee organized health inspection of the students of B.A., B.Sc., B.Com. and M.A. streams by Dr. Jhuma Hazra and documented the reviews/observations of the doctor. The committee took special efforts to ensure that the outstation students got the priority to receive the benefits of the health check-up.
- The members of the Medical Committee of the college felt that since Kolkata has become infamous for Dengue in the recent past hence there was an immediate need to organize a seminar to get a deep insight on the problem and its possible prevention. In view of this, the Medical Committee of the college conducted a "Health Awareness Talk on Dengue" for the students of the B.Ed. department on 3rd October from 1-2 pm. The Chief Guest and speaker was Dr. Mainak Malhotra, Senior consultant of AMRI Hospitals, Mukundapur.



As per the recommendation of the IQAC of the college, the Medical Committee organised a Mental Health Workshop titled "Emotional First Aid" conducted by an organisation called Emosync. Mr Azhar Khurshid and his team conducted this 2 hour workshop for the B.Sc students of the college on 10th May, 2019. The medical committee also conducted a feedback from the 65 participants to assess the relevance and effectiveness of such workshops.
