- **BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE EVENT:**

Like every year, in 2026 too, the B.Ed. department of Shri Shikshayatan College arranged an institutional visit as a part of “*Creating an Inclusive School*” and the Community Outreach Service Unit activity.

On 25.03.2026, eight students of the B.Ed. department visited Manovikas Kendra to observe and understand the teaching-learning methods of children with special needs. The B. Ed. trainees got to know about the teaching learning process and materials used to teach the children with special needs such as individualized education plans (IEPs), visual aids, communication boards, sensory toys, and therapeutic tools. The B. Ed. trainees also learned about the multidisciplinary approach including speech therapy, occupational therapy, and behavioural interventions. In addition, B. Ed. trainees became familiar with the history of the institution, the various co-curricular and vocational activities conducted for the learners, and the achievements of the students in different fields. From the B. Ed. department materials like pencil container, eraser container, sketch pens set, sharpeners box, wax crayon boxes, colour pencil sets, shape sorter set, toy blocks building puzzle set, modelling dough set, abacus, the alphabet chart, chess set, chocolates packet were donated to support the students of the school.

- **OUTCOME:**

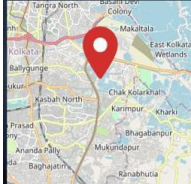
