Date & Venue: 10th August 2026 | Red Road (via Prinsep Ghat), Kolkata

EVENT 3: DUAL AWARENESS RALLY (HAR GHAR TIRANGA & ANTI-RAGGING)

Date & Venue: 13th August 2026 | College Neighborhood (Lord Sinha Road, Elgin Road, Shakespeare Sarani)

Topic: Patriotic Spirit & Campus Safety Awareness

Description: The NSS Unit organized a **combined awareness rally** covering key streets around the college neighborhood, including *Lord Sinha Road, Elgin Road, and Shakespeare Sarani*.
