Brief Description

The NSS Unit of Shri Shikshayatan College, in collaboration with the Hope Foundation, participated in a Free Dental Care Camp held on 7th August, 2026 at Tilijala Topsia. The objective of the programme was to provide accessible dental care services to the community and create awareness about the importance of regular dental check-ups and timely treatment.

The camp witnessed an encouraging response from the local community. A total of **50 patients** underwent free dental examinations conducted by qualified Orthodontist, Prosthodontist and medical staff. Following the examination, **50 beneficiaries received free dental ket** according to their prescriptions. Patients requiring immediate medical attention were provided with free medicines, while those diagnosed with serious dental conditions were advised to undergo free tooth surgery based on their examination reports.

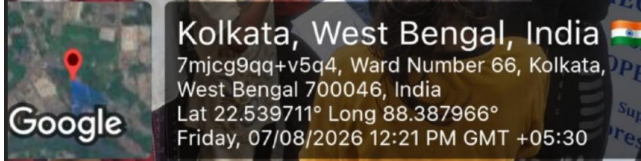
Two NSS volunteers from Shri Shikshayatan College, under the supervision of three faculty members, actively assisted in organizing the programme. The volunteers managed patient registration, maintained records, guided beneficiaries through different examination counters, coordinated crowd management, and ensured that every patient reached the doctors in a systematic manner. Their support helped the programme run smoothly and efficiently.

The camp not only delivered essential eye care services but also reflected the spirit of social responsibility and community engagement. The event offered students an opportunity to work closely with healthcare professionals, interact with people from different backgrounds, and understand the importance of volunteering in public welfare initiatives.

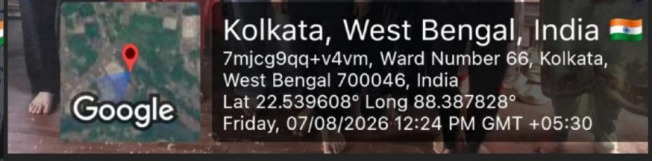
Outcome

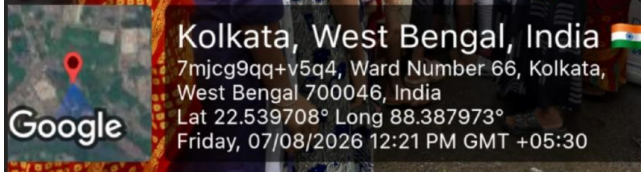
