

NSS Activity Report for The Session 2017-2018

The volunteers of the NSS unit had done multiple activities on the 2017-2018 session under the supervision of the teachers of the NSS committee. On 12.09.2017 the orientation program for the new volunteers was held with a welcome address by the NSS Program Officer, Dr. Agnita Kundu. On 18.09.2017 the NSS volunteers organized a drive to collect school supplies and all the things collected were packed and donated to school children of our adopted Motijheel slum. NSS Day was celebrated on 02.11.2017. Madiha Ahmad, an ex-student of our college and currently, a social entrepreneur herself delivered a talk, My Life, My Journey. On November 14, 2017, the volunteers visited the Society for Indian Children's Welfare with 15 other volunteers to commemorate Children's Day. On Mother's Day, the college's NSS unit donated supper and breakfast, and the students spent time on December 3, 2017, with the Little Sisters of the Poor's inmates. On December 14, 2017, Dr. Nazneen Nahar Begam of the School of Tropical Medicine led an interactive discussion on AIDS awareness.

Special Camp: In partnership with the NGO Ektara, the NSS special camp was held at the Topsia slum from 13.1.18 to 19.1.18. Staff members from Ektara provided volunteers instructions on specific topics. For Classes I, II, and III of Ektara, the NSS Volunteers conducted a model-making session in order to facilitate learning. They also created charts and distributed saplings.

There was a test on the subjects covered in class, then a film on empowerment of girls, "Neel Batey Sannate" was screened. The volunteers and kids from the Topsia Slum participated in a cleanliness effort (Swachh Bharat). The Lions Club of Kolkata held an eye camp on January

18th. A cultural performance by the Ektara youngsters brought the celebration to an end. Finally, Ektara was presented an Indoor Games Center.

A state-level seminar on challenges and prospects of a social Outreach program in city-Based Colleges was held on 11.5.2018 in collaboration with IQAC of the college. Programme Officers of St. Xaviers College, Loreto College, Women's Christians College, South Calcutta Girls' College, Deshabandhu Girls' College, Acharya Jagadish Chandra Bose College and Ashutosh College attended and deliberated. Finally, at the end of this session world environment day was celebrated on 05.06.2018 at the University of Calcutta.
