#### NSS activity report for the Session 2019-2020

Under the guidance of the NSS committee teachers, the volunteers of the NSS unit participated in a number of activities during the 2019–2020 academic year. The orientation event for new volunteers was held on August 19, and the NSS Program Officer gave a welcome speech., a dengue eradication campaign was held on 30.8.19. , NSS students visited the Little Sisters of the Poor for a monthly birthday celebration at little sisters of the poor on 17.9.19. An NGO, Blood Connect hosted an orientation workshop on 19.9.19 to encourage students to donate blood. A blood donation camp in collaboration with Lions Club and Bloodconnect was held at the college, where more than 100 donors gave their blood on 8.11.19. Donation ofclothes in collaboration with Leo Club was held in September,2019. The 50<sup>th</sup>-anniversary celebration of NSS at Calcutta University held on 24.9.19. Before Durga Puja new clothes were given to the children of SICW AND UMEED on 27.9.19 . The NSS volunteers set up a stall at the Little Sisters of the Poor fete on 1.12.19 and the proceeds were donated to the old age home. Blankets were distributed to the local street dwellers on 7.1.20.

A special camp 2019-20 session was held from 18.2.20 to 25.2.20 in UMEED and Assembly of God Church Vocational School, both NGOs cater to the residents of the Topsia area. At UMEED, volunteers were divided into two subgroups one for girls and the other for boys to teach them rhymes and help them make crafts. Some school stationery were gifted to the students of UMEED. At the Assembly of God Church Vocational School There are some awareness programmes on Menstrual hygiene was organized and sanitary napkins were distributed in collaboration with AG GIRLS. A free eye camp by Lions Club and a stall of used cloth, bag, and accessories called ANANDAMELA were put up. Along with this some more activities were carried out: Swach Bharat campaign by all the students in lord Sinha road, and pamphlet

distribution for the awareness to save water. After the lockdown due to COVID, programmes were held in an online mode.
