- ◆ A creative writing and case study for Blood Donation with Blood Connect was organized on 5/2/2021.

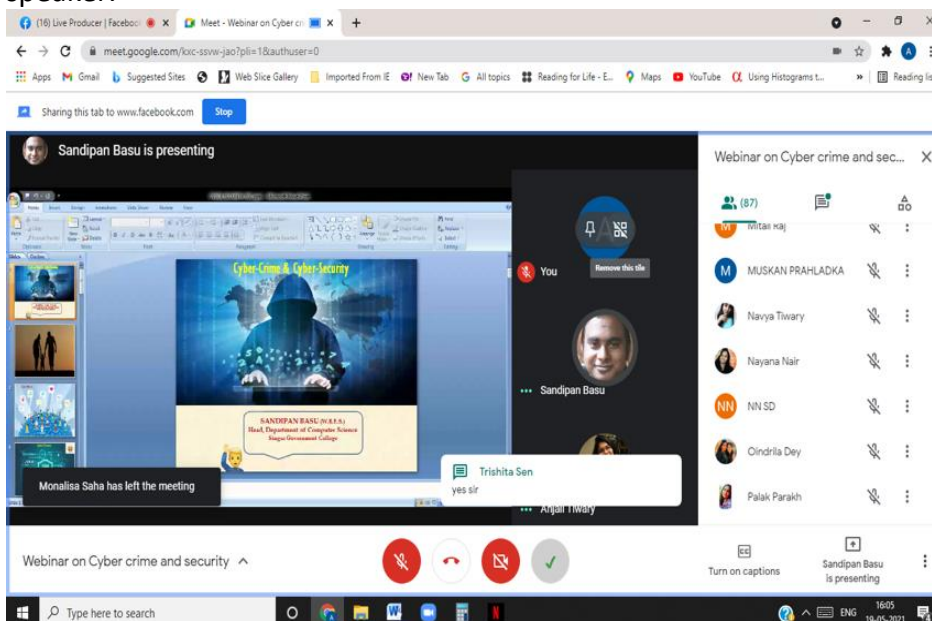
