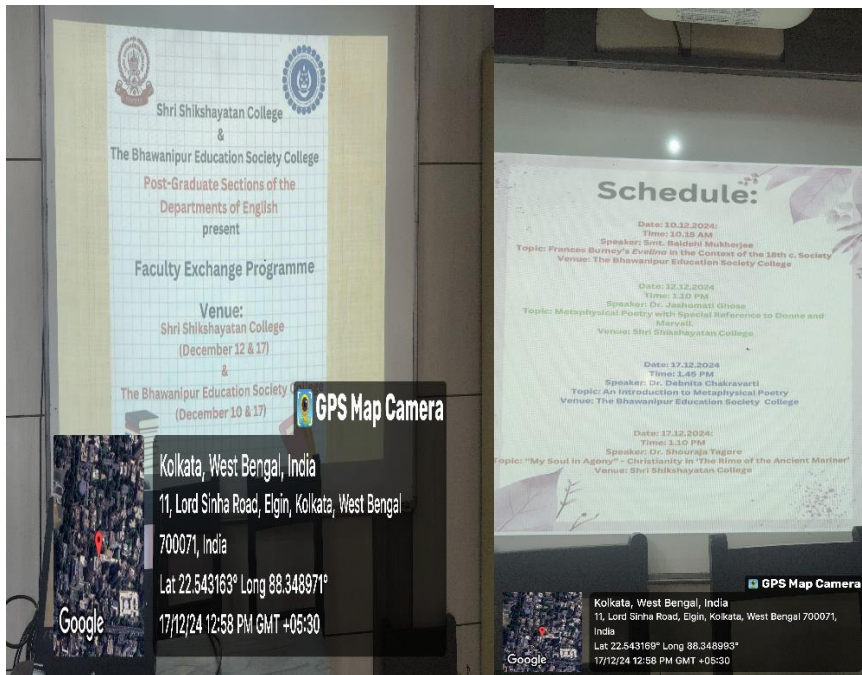

- **BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE EVENT:** The Faculty Exchange Programme was an initiative to exchange resources, ideas, innovation and sharing of knowledge and skills by the faculty members of the two departments of the two colleges mentioned, as an outcome of the MoU signed. The purpose was to present topics pertaining to the P.G. Semester I syllabus more lucidly to the students to open up avenues of learning. The first day was hosted by The Bhawanipur Education Society College on December 10, 2024, where **Smt. Baidehi Mukherjee**, Assistant Professor & P.G. Coordinator, Department of English, Shri Shikshayatan College presented the lecture on **Frances Burney's *Evelina* in the Context of the 18th C. Society**. Shri Shikshayatan College had hosted the second day: December 12, 2024, where **Dr. Jashomati Ghose**, Assistant Professor, Department of English, The Bhawanipur Education Society College had delivered her talk on **Introduction to Metaphysical Poetry with Special Reference to Donne and Marvell**. The third day, December 17, 2024 was hosted by both the colleges for the last series of lectures as a part of the Faculty Exchange Programme. Dr. Debnita Chakravarti, Associate Professor, Department of English, Shri Shikshayatan College, had delivered a lecture on the **Introduction to Metaphysical Poetry** and Dr. Souraja Tagore, Assistant Professor, Department of English, The Bhawanipur Education Society College, had delivered a talk on **'My Soul in Agony': Christianity in Coleridge's "The Rime of the Ancient Mariner"**.
- **OUTCOME:** The desired outcome was to exchange our respective resources to make the process of learning more innovative and less monotonous. Some of the tools used by the faculty members proved very fruitful to the entire process of the exchange. The students' interaction helped every learner to be motivated towards thinking beyond the regular
