- BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE EVENT: The Faculty Exchange Programme was an initiative to exchange resources, ideas, innovation and sharing of knowledge and skills by the faculty members of the two departments of the two colleges mentioned, as an outcome of the MoU signed. The third day and the final day, September 9, 2025 was hosted by Shri Shikshayatan College, where Smt. Anwesha Ray, Faculty, P.G. Section, Department of English, Basanti Devi College delivered her talk on Agony of the Displaced: Studying Amitav Ghosh's Depiction of the Sundarbans in *The Hungry Tide*.

 faculty members proved very fruitful to the entire process of the exchange. The students'
 interaction helped every learner to be motivated towards thinking beyond the regular
