- **Brief Description of the Event** – The B.Ed. Department of Shri Shikshayatan College organized a Film Review Event on the movie *Samantara* (2017) to deepen students' understanding of gender sensitization and the psychological dimensions of identity and social roles. The screening of the film offered significant insights into themes such as patriarchy, mental health, familial control, gendered expectations, and individual autonomy. Through post-screening discussions and interactive analysis, students examined the characters, narrative structure, and underlying social messages presented in the film. The session created a reflective space for participants to explore how societal norms influence personal freedom, especially in the context of gender and power dynamics.
- **Outcome** – The event aimed to enhance students' awareness of gender sensitivity by encouraging them to question rigid social structures and stereotypical gender roles. It fostered empathy, critical thinking, and open dialogue regarding equality, mental well-being, and individual rights. The discussion helped students develop a more nuanced and socially responsible perspective, equipping them to promote inclusivity and sensitivity in both educational and societal settings.
