- **BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE EVENT:** The event marked an interesting literary presentation by the students on Agatha Christie, as the Author of the Month for September 2025. The event was a celebration of the contribution of Christie to literature. The students referred to the different literary texts to emphasise on the theme chosen. As a Post-graduate department of literature, the 'Author of the Month' events mark the commemoration and the literary contributions of the various literary stalwarts. September 15 marks the 135th birth anniversary of Agatha Christie and the students have managed to relive moments from Christie's literary characters and tropes. This has an additional impact on their process of learning and presenting as a group activity.
