

**Report on Medicinal Plant Awareness Programme as a Part of the Observation of Students' Week, 2026 – organised by ComEnS**

BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE EVENT: As part of the observation of Students' Week, 2026, an environmental awareness programme was organised with the theme, "Heal the world: Plant, for the planet" by Committee of Environment and Sustainability (ComEnS) of Shri Shikshayatan College. A special corner dedicated to the medicinal plant Indian Basil (Tulsi) was created. The corner was accompanied by charts prepared and displayed by students highlighting the multiple medicinal and ecological benefits of tulsi. Poems focusing on the need to conserve nature and protect the planet were read by the students, fostering awareness and sensitivity towards environmental issues. As an extension of the programme, paper bags made by the students were distributed among local shopkeepers to encourage the reduction of plastic usage and promote sustainable practices within the community.

OUTCOME: The programme successfully sensitised students and the local community to the importance of environmental conservation and sustainable living. It promoted awareness about the medicinal benefits of the Indian Basil, the need to conserve plants, and the harmful effects of plastic. The activities encouraged students to take responsibility towards the environment and strengthened community engagement through the distribution of eco-friendly paper bags.
