

Report on the Educational Trip organised by the Department of Education

EVENT: Institutional Visit to Rammohan Memorial Museum and trip to Eco Park

Date: Thursday, 19th December 2024

Time: 11:30 AM to 6:00 pm

Participants: 37 students and 3 faculty

DESCRIPTION:

The Department of Education, Shri Shikshayatan College organised an institutional visit to Rammohan Memorial Museum, Kolkata followed by a trip to Eco Park on 19th December 2024. 37 Students of the 5th and 3rd Semester, of Education Honours/Major, accompanied by three faculty members took a guided tour in the first floor of the elegant colonial building – one of the residences of Raja Rammohan Roy. Smt. Sudeshna Banerjee, the assigned guide, explained explicitly the significance of the exhibits – pictures, period furniture, paintings, books, panels and commemorative items such as stamps, seals, historical documents that helped the participants to get an idea of the life and time of Raja Rammohan Roy.

After the institutional visit, the students and faculties went to Eco Park where packed lunch was served. Students and teachers spent some enjoyable time at the park. Students and faculty members contributed towards the expenses incurred on transport and lunch, arranged through Dear Travels, while the expenses for entry fee, breakfast and evening snacks were borne by the college.

OUTCOME

The institutional visit gave an opportunity to the students for experiential learning and better understanding of the time when Raja Rammohan Roy lived, his contributions and the background of Bengal Renaissance. Students were particularly moved by the exhibits depicting suttee. Visit to Eco Park gave them the opportunity for recreational and physical activities, development of leadership qualities and organizational skills and enhanced teacher-student interaction.
