Brief Description of Event : A seminar entitled "Bullying in Educational Settings: Prevention, Intervention, Introspection" conducted by the Anjali Educational Foundation in Collaboration with the University of Calcutta; brought together experts from across diverse fields to deliberate on the growing concern of bullying in educational institutions. Through a series of informative sessions and discussions, the speakers explored the causes, consequences, and preventive strategies related to bullying while emphasizing the importance of creating safe, inclusive, and supportive learning environments. The seminar concluded with a collaborative panel discussion that highlighted the shared responsibility of educators, parents, students, and mental health professionals in addressing bullying effectively.
