Brief Description of the event: 2 January: A session titled 'Psychometric tests Analysis' was organised by the Department of Commerce (Evening), in association with Pune Institute of Business Management. It was attended by 38 students.

3 January: The Medical Committee of the college arranged for a session on Art Therapy by Dr Oihika Chakrabarti entitled 'An Introduction to Art Therapy and Its Diverse Implications to Address Mental Health Challenges'. 104 students attended the programme and benefitted from practical advice and guidance with discussion of individual case studies.

4 January: An interactive session on the Students' Credit Card Scheme was conducted by Smt Debolina Guha Thakurta, Assistant professor, Department of English, the current college Nodal Officer of the scheme. 44 students attended the programme and were apprised of the many benefits of the scheme.

5 January: 15 participants of UG and PG students of the Department of English gave two audio-visual presentations. The theme was on Youth Empowerment and Social Outreach. The session was attended by 62 students.

5 January: The B.Com. (Evening) Department organised an awareness session on the Aviation Industry in collaboration with Future Flyers Aviation Academy. 39 students were made aware of cabin crew career opportunities.

6 January: A debate was organised for all streams by the Debating Society of the college, DebSoc. 19 students participated in the preliminary round of the event; subsequently 10 students were selected for the final round. The motion for the final debate was "Climate change is not the greatest threat facing humanity today'. The event was conducted online.

8 January: B.Com. (Morning) Department organised a presentation titled 'Local Going Global'. 24 students made the presentation while 60 students attended the session. The session discussed the use of technology, knowledge and experience to scale up local practices to global standards.

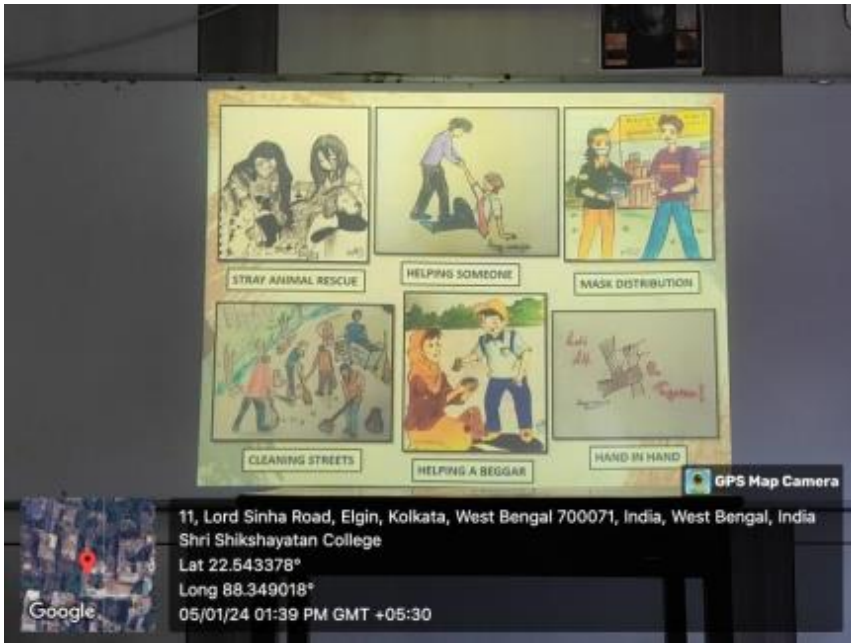

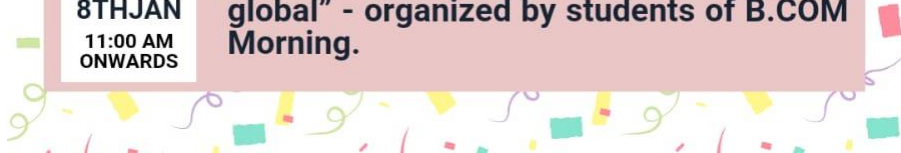

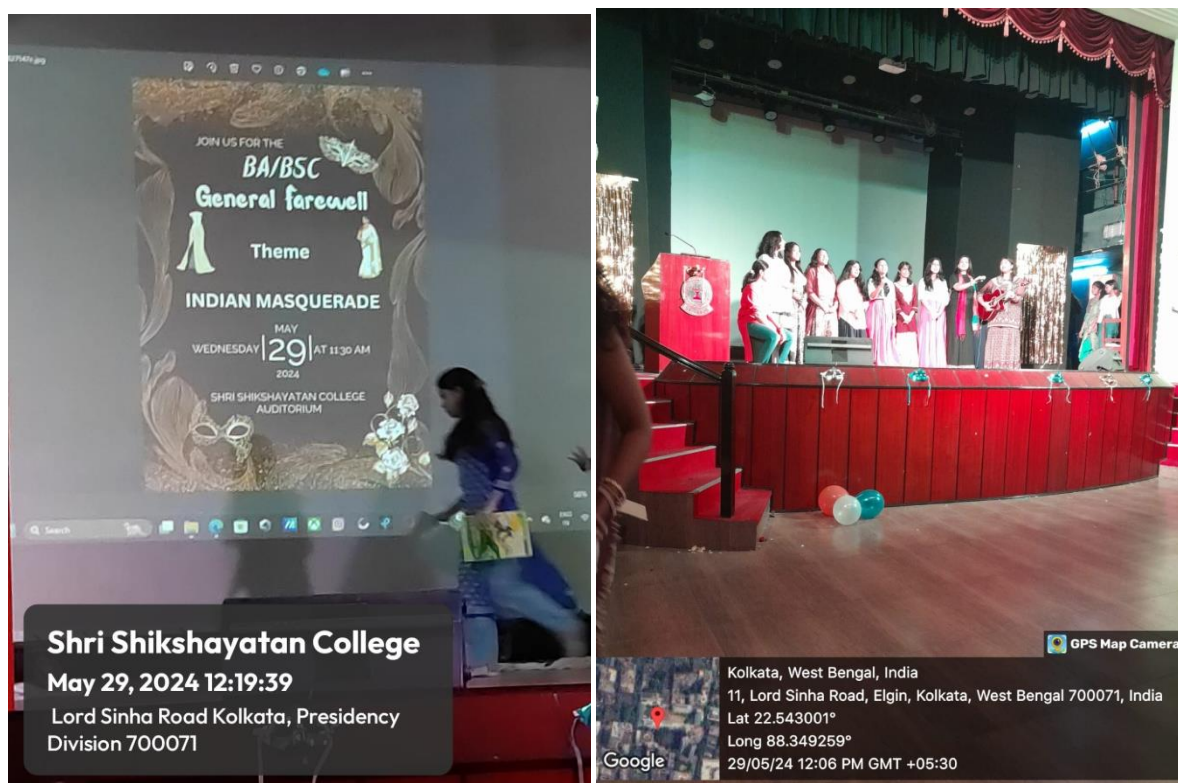
