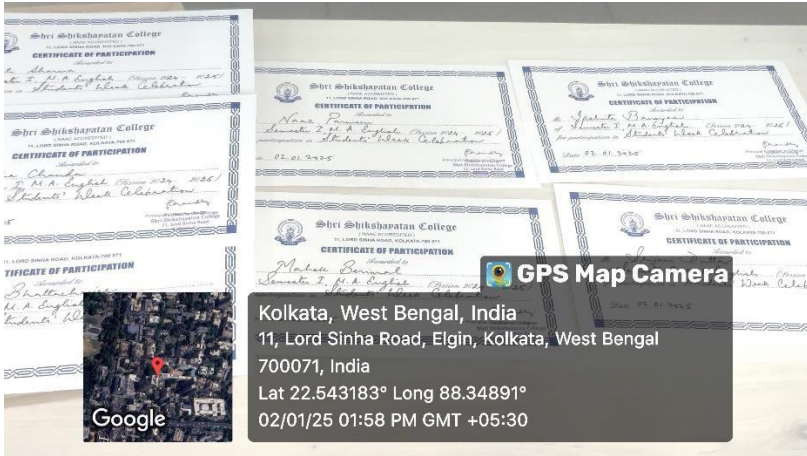
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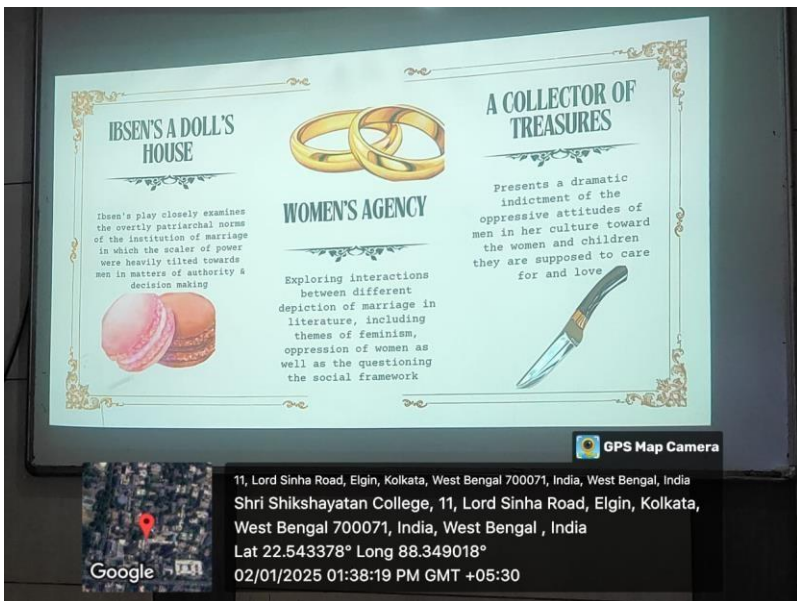
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Freshers' Debate 2025

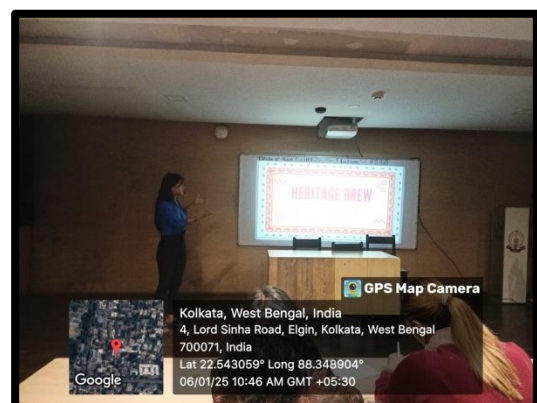

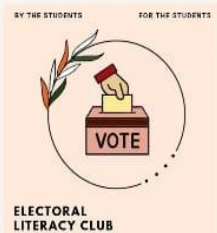

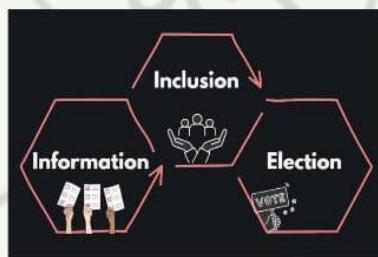
Outcome: The session contributed to enhancing students' as well as the teachers' conceptual understanding about the electoral process in India.

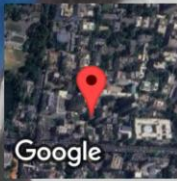
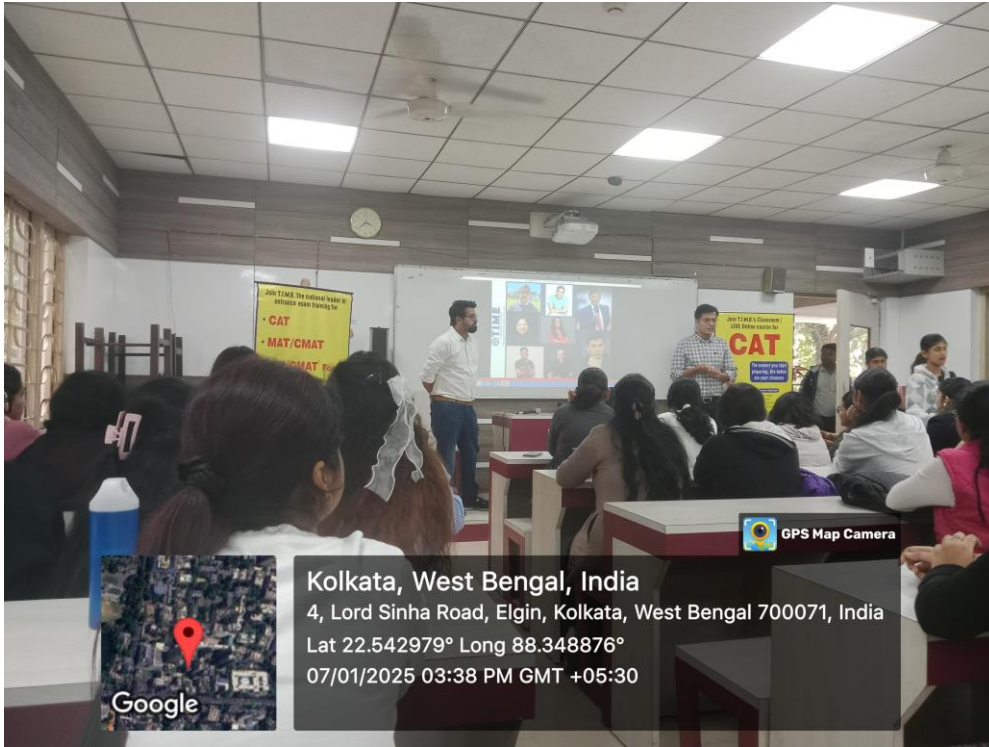

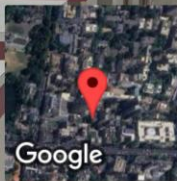
